USTA Mississippi League Ambassador

Description

USTA Mississippi is seeking individuals to serve as “USTA League Ambassadors” to create and captain USTA League teams for all USTA league programs.

The goal of the initiative is to have individuals contact players looking for teams, lapsed players, and new players to place them onto teams. The ambassador would then serve as the captain of the team and mentor team members to take over the role.

Duties

- Actively contact lapsed players and players looking for teams (a list of each will be provided)
- Talk to local providers, coaches, and pros to see if they have players looking for teams or if they will put together an “interest list” at that facility with contact information of players that can be solicited for team participation
- Place interested players on teams, create the team numbers, and facilitate players getting signed up
- Serve as the captain of the team (schedule matches, send out lineups, designate a player to be the “acting” captain at the match, help mentor a player to take over as captain)
- Ambassadors can captain as many teams during a season as they would like.

Benefits & Requirements

- Ambassadors will receive \$150 for each team they captain (*local CTA's in some areas may provide additional stipends per team*)
- Ambassador's name must be listed on the team in Tennislink as the captain or co-captain
- Ambassador must be “pre approved” to be an ambassador to qualify for the payout
- To qualify for payout, at least 4 members of the team must be a NEW LEAGUE PLAYER OR ONE THAT HAS NOT PARTICIPATED IN League in the past 12 months.
- Ambassadors will fill out a Google Reporting Form to let us know which teams they submitted
